

# Repertoire Grading Guidelines

- A (90-100%) = Accuracy with dynamics and musical elements
- B (80-89%) = Accuracy with dynamics and musical elements present, but not consistent
- C (70-79%) = Weak in either accuracy or dynamics/musical elements
- D (60-69%) = Weak in both accuracy and dynamics/musical elements

Based on the number of points for each piece at each level, range of points for each grade:

## **Level 1A, 1B, 1C = 34 points for each piece, including memory.**

- A = 30.5 – 34 pts.
- B = 27 – 30 pts.
- C = 23.5 – 26.5 pts.
- D = 20 – 23 pts.

## **Level 2 = 23 points for each piece, including memory.**

- A = 20.5 – 23 pts.
- B = 18 – 20 pts.
- C = 16 – 17.5 pts.
- D = 13.5 – 15.5 pts.

## **Level 3 = 34 points for each piece, including memory.**

- A = 30.5 – 34 pts.
- B = 27 – 30 pts.
- C = 23.5 – 26.5 pts.
- D = 20 – 23 pts.

## **Level 4-9 = 24 points for each piece, including memory.**

Only 2 pieces are required to be memorized, therefore, students can earn extra 2 bonus points for successfully memorizing the 3<sup>rd</sup> piece. (Perfect possible score of 102 pts.)

- A = 21.5 – 24 pts.
- B = 19 – 21 pts.
- C = 16.5 – 18.5 pts.
- D = 14 – 16 pts.

## **Level 10-12 = 18 points. for each piece, including memory.**

Only 2 pieces are required to be memorized, therefore, students can earn extra 2 or 4 bonus points for successfully memorizing the 3<sup>rd</sup> and/or 4<sup>th</sup> piece. (Perfect possible score of 104 pts.)

- A = 16 – 18 pts.
- B = 14.5 – 15.5 pts.
- C = 12.5 – 14 pts.
- D = 11-12 pts.

### **For Memory:**

- Circle “yes” or “no” on the score sheet. A piece is considered not memorized only if student is unable to complete the performance without the music.
- If a student has memory stumble(s) and/or has to look at the music, but is able to complete the performance without music, the piece is considered memorized and please mark as “yes.”

**For bonus memory points, the same criteria should be upheld.**
